expectations

<p>Communication</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Use manners when communicating with adults and other students  Say thank you to the driver at the end of your trip  Communicate with other students, adults and drivers using respectful oral/body language and tone  Quickly let an adult know if there is a problem – the bus driver or a teacher at school
<p>Understanding</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Follow the guidelines of the driver in regards to eating and drinking  Not bullying people.
<p>Trust</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Being responsible for your own belongings.  Keep the vehicles free of aggression, violence, bullying and harassment  Keep the vehicles free of graffiti, vandalism and theft  Respect own, each other and vehicle property  Responsibly move at all times in a manner that is safe  Stay seated when the vehicle is travelling  If given a designated seat remain in it  Follow the guidelines of the driver in regards to eating and drinking  Take rubbish with you. Don't leave it in the vehicle or throw it out of the window
<p>Collaboration</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Ensure that you are always doing the right thing so that everyone is safe  Be willing to move seats if and when necessary.
<p>Relationships</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Respect the driver. It is their job to transport you safely. This happens when the passengers are doing the right thing  Respond positively to reasonable directions of others  Make an effort to be friendly to everyone.  Respond positively to reasonable directions of others  Treat everyone with respect.

Consequences:

Step 1: A warning letter is sent home stating that an unacceptable behaviour has occurred and that the next time there may be a suspension from the bus. There will be an in-school consequence.

Step 2: If another incident occurs, 2 day suspension from the bus starting the day following the offence, parents will be notified.

Step 3: If another incident occurs student will be suspended for a period of at least one week.

(If a serious safety breach occurs then it is possible to go straight to step 2 or 3)
